

# Franklin Wharf

## Improvements Project

PROJECT UPDATE #1

27 OCTOBER 2009

The Sullivans Cove Waterfront Authority and Tasports are working together to improve Franklin Wharf through a program of public space improvements. Stage 1 of the improvements has just commenced and focuses on the area between the two dock bridges. This work will be completed by mid December in time for the 2009 Sydney to Hobart Yacht Race finish festivities.

Regular construction updates will be posted on the Kings Pier Marina and Elizabeth Street Pier Service Structures.

The project is being managed to minimise disruption, however some traffic and parking interruption will occur during construction (please refer to table below for more detail). Your patience is appreciated.

Removal of car park line marking	27 to 29 Oct 2009	Reduced parking.	Double row adjacent to Heritage Crane. See ①.
Removal of car park line marking	30 Oct 2009	Reduced parking and road closure.	From the Constitution Dock Bridge to the T-intersection next to Mures. See ① and ②.
Line marking for new car parking layout	30 Oct to 3 Nov 2009	Reduced parking and road closure.	From the bridge to the T-intersection next to Mures. See ① and ②.
Replacement of speed limit signs	early Nov 2009	Introduction of new 30km/hr speed limit.	Across Franklin Wharf.
<b>Low Landing</b>			
Installation of tiered timber bleachers	Nov 2009	Lower landing fenced off from public use (including boats).	Lower landing adjacent to Constitution Dock entrance. See ③.
Installation of ramp and fence	late Nov to early Dec 2009	Lower landing fenced off from public use (including boats).	Lower landing adjacent to Constitution Dock entrance. See ④.
<b>Viewing Platform</b>			
Installation of viewing platform	early to mid Dec 2009	Minor disruption to the public space.	Adjacent to lower landing and new bleachers. See ⑤.
<b>Pavement Graphic</b>			
Repositioning of crane	mid Nov 2009	Road closure.	From the bridge to the T-intersection next to Mures. See ⑥.
Application of pavement graphic	late Nov to mid Dec 2009	Reduced parking and disruption to the use of public space.	Area around the steam crane and lower landing. See ⑥.
