



## CONVERSATIONS IN THE COVE

Conversations in the Cove is a series of public forums covering issues of importance to the future of Sullivans Cove and surrounding areas.

A typical event involves a presentation by a guest speaker followed by audience discussion. Guest speakers include specialists in architecture, urban design, landscape architecture, engineering and related fields.

Entry to Conversations in the Cove is always free.

### What happens at Conversations in the Cove?

Conversations in the Cove is a chance to:

- » Meet members of the Sullivans Cove Waterfront Authority and Sullivans Cove Design Panel
- » Get an inside look at the ideas, aspirations and insights of those who care about the future of the Hobart waterfront
- » Gather key stakeholders at a single venue for informed discussion about important issues
- » Bring experts face-to-face with members of the local community
- » Share personal stories about Hobart's history and heritage
- » Establish a platform for future interaction and possible partnerships between all those who live in, work in or like to visit Sullivans Cove.

Importantly, Conversations in the Cove offers a forum for lively dialogue and penetrating questions about the future direction of the Hobart waterfront.
